

State aforesaid in consideration of One hundred and thirty three Dollars and fifty cents to me in hand paid by Berry Wilson of Spartanburg County and State aforesaid have bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release to the said Berry Wilson all our right title or claim in the real estate of my father Thomas A Campbell deceased the said road estate being situate and lying in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid on waters of Beaver-dam creek adjoining lands with Rubin Budduth and William Mitchell and others containing one hundred acres more or less together with all and singular the rights numbers hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Berry Wilson his heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Berry Wilson his heirs and assigns against us and our heirs and every other person whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
