Know all men by these presents  
that I R H Earle assignee of

a mortgage given by Moses

Dill to Alex Mcbee dated 14<sup>th</sup> April 1878 in consideration  
of One thousand Dollars to me paid by R H Earle of Greenville  
County, in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained sold<sup>and</sup>  
released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and  
release unto the said R H Earle all that piece parcel and  
tract of land containing One hundred and twenty three acres  
one  $\frac{1}{2}$  and  $\frac{1}{2}$  poles on the North and South Forks of Brushy  
Creek about four miles from the City of Greenville, and more  
particularly described by metes and bounds courses and distances  
in the above mentioned mortgage to which reference is hereby  
directed - the land having been sold under the terms of said  
mortgage at public auction on Monday the 4<sup>th</sup> day of February  
1878 at Greenville to me and the said R H Earle being the highest  
bidder at the sum above mentioned. Together with all and  
singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances  
to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or app-  
ertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises  
before mentioned, unto the said R H Earle his heirs and  
assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs exec-  
utors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and  
singular the said premises unto the said R H Earle his heirs  
and assigns, against me and my heirs and every other  
person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the  
same or any part thereof.
