692 Sarah Ann Foster & Sam'l W Foster to James Daunister	Dated	The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that we, Sarah Ann Foster and Samuel W Foster of Greenville County, in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Seventy * Dollars to us paid by James Daunister of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release, unto the said James Daunister all our right title and claim which is one half; in all that tract of land situated lying and being in State and County aforesaid adjoining lands of Mary Gordon Delila Green and James Daunister, containing Thirty two acres more or less Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said James Daunister his heirs and assigns forever, and we do hereby bind our heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises, unto the said James Daunister his heirs and assigns against us and our heirs, and every other person whom soever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof, Witness our hands and seals this 2nd day of April in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy seven and in the 101 <sup>st</sup> year of the independence of the United States of America.
