The State of South Carolina  
Known all men by these presents,  
that I Joseph Edwards of Greenville  
County in the State aforesaid  
in consideration of the sum of Fourteen hundred Dollars to me in  
hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by Charles Weyne  
of Greenville County in the state aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby  
acknowledged), have granted bargained sold and released and by these  
presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Charles Weyne  
a certain tract or parcel of land being on Morrow Bone Creek, branch  
waters of Ecorse River, containing One hundred and one acres more or  
less, being part of a tract originally granted to Elisha Simmons the  
first day of December One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety four  
beginning on a chestnut 3x0 m on Morrow Bone Creek, thence S $15\frac{1}{2}$ E  
63.79 chains to a small P O oxen thence N $61\frac{1}{2}$ E 9.25 chains to a P O oxen  
thence N $76\frac{1}{2}$ E 2.83 chains to a chestnut 3x0 m thence N $2\frac{1}{2}$ W 56.12 ch-  
ains to a small sweet gum 3x0 m on the Morrow Bone Creek thence  
N $89$  W up the meanders of said Creek to the beginning, also all  
that other tract or parcel of land lying on Morrow Bone Creek, branch  
waters of Ecorse River, adjoining the above and a part of the same  
grants, containing Ninety acres more or less, Beginning at a sweet  
gum at the mouth of a branch running thence S $3\frac{1}{4}$  E 55.87 chains  
to a chestnut 3x0 m thence N $76\frac{1}{4}$  E 7.75 chs to a stake, thence N $52\frac{1}{2}$   
E 7.10 chs to a maple (gone) thence N $50$  E 5.22 chs to a pine 3x3 m  
thence N $2\frac{1}{4}$  E 8.48 chains to a stone on the edge of Brushy Creek  
Road, thence N $10\frac{1}{4}$  W 42.67 chs to an Ivy bush dead on Narrow-  
bone, thence up the meanders of Morrowbone branch to the  
beginning. Together with all and singular the rights members heredit-  
aments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise  
incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said pre-  
mises before mentioned unto the said Charles Weyne his heirs and  
assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and  
administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said  
premises unto the said Charles Weyne his heirs and assigns against  
me and my heirs, and every other person lawfully claiming or to claim  
the same or any part thereof.

paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by Ballie V Deattie of  
the City and County of Greenville in the state aforesaid (the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained sold and released  
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the  
said Ballie V Deattie all that piece parcel and tract of land situate  
lying and being in Greenville County State of South Carolina, on  
Middle Fork of Saluda River, containing fifteen hundred and  
eleven acres more or less, having such lines, metes and bounda-  
ries as are represented in a plat of the same made by James W  
Dickson D J bearing date the 24<sup>th</sup> day of January A D 1870. The  
said tract being composed of several tracts or parcels of land pur-  
chased at different times by my Grand father Jeremiah Cleveland  
deceased and being the same tract conveyed to me by Jesse Cleveland  
Trustee of Greenville County State of Georgia by Deed bearing date the  
20<sup>th</sup> day of November A D 1875, by authority of the Court of Common
