Now know all men, that I, the said S J Douthit Probate Judge as aforesaid in consideration of the premises, and also in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and Seventy Dollars paid me by the said W V Barkley, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said W V Barkley and his heirs and assigns, all that tract of land, situate lying and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, on waters of Lynne Creek, adjoining lands of W H Evans, Barkley, Tracts No 2 and 4 and containing one hundred and four and a half acres, more or less, known in the division of the real estate of J Dunklin Sullivan deceased, as tract No 3.
