


Henderson all that lot or parcel of land situated on the corner of John and Cross streets in the City of Greenville and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake 3 rd W Davis corner, on John Street, and running thence along said Davis line S 40° W. to a stake at N. 166 feet distant, thence along W A Henderson's line S 50° E 91 feet to a stake at on cross street thence along said street N 40° E 166 feet to a stake on John Street and thence along John Street N 50° W 91 feet to the beginning corner containing thirty five one hundredths of an acre more or less.
