presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said J H Taylor
all that piece parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the
City of Greenville in the State aforesaid, containing one and three
fifth acres, more or less, Beginning at a stake on Lawrence Road
Being the S E corner of Mrs. Thompson's lot, and running thence
one hundred and seventy five feet with said road to a stake on a
cross street thirty feet wide, thence with said cross street four
hundred and forty six and a half feet to a stake on a back street,
thence with said back street one hundred and forty seven feet to
a stake, being the N E corner of Mrs. Thompson's lot, thence
four hundred and forty seven and a half feet to the beginning,
being lot No 4 in the division of the real estate of Edward Cough
deceased, together with all and singular the rights, members, fixtures
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in
anywise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and
singular the premises before mentioned unto the said J H Taylor
his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my
heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever
defend all and singular the said premises unto the said

iam Carter Taylor in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained sold and released, and
by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said
William Carter Taylor all that piece parcel or tract of land situate lying
and being in the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid, about two
and one half miles from Greenville to W. on the Anderson or Bush
ans Bridge Road, being a portion of the tract of land conveyed
to me by B F Perry, containing three acres, and having the following
metes and bounds, courses and distances, as shown by a plat of
the same made by J. A. Southern & S. on 20th day of January
1879 hereto attached to and beginning at a Red oak 3x3x32 in on
the Anderson Road thence N 76 1/4 E 45 55 to stone 3x3 in thence N 44
68 25 to stake 3x in old road, thence N 48 W 8 30 to stone 3x2 in
in road, thence along the Anderson Road to the beginning corner
