N 56 E 11.60 ch to a stone S x N W on Mr. Glanahans and to lands old  
line, thence with said line N 42 1/4 W 11, goes to a stake S x N W line  
S 56 W 8.00 ch to a stone on said white Horse road S x N W line along  
said road as a line to the beginning corner and adjoining lands of Mr.  
Glanahan deed and A. D. Cobb. Together with all and singular the  
rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
