I S J Douthit Master of the County of Greenville in the said State, send greeting: whereas Matthew Mansel, Frank- ey Parrot, Jane French Richard Leinhardt, Lizzie Berry, Sarah Turner and Mary King on or about the 19 th day of July in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy nine did exhibit their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid against Samuel Mansel, Joseph Mansel, Samuel Mansel, Julia Mansel and others.
