To all to whom these presents shall come or be made known, for whom the same may in anywise concern I S J Douthit Master of the County of Greenville in the said State send greeting: Whereas Mathew Mansel, Franky Burnet, James French, Richard Lenhardt, Lizzie Berry, Sarah Turner, and Mary King on or about the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy nine did exhibit their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, against Samuel Mansel, Joseph Mansel, Samuel Mansel, Julia Mansel and others, and the cause being at issue before the Honorable Court aforesaid, came on to be heard on the sixth day of October one thousand eight hundred and seventy nine when the said Court after a full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in the premises, did order adjudge and decree that the tract of land belonging to the estate of Aaron Thompson deceased herein after mentioned and described should be sold at public auction by S J Douthit Master

of Greenville County, in the terms, and for the purposes mentioned in said decreed order, as by reference thereto, on file in the paid Court will appear, and the said S J Douthit Master as aforesaid after having duly advertised the said tract of land for twenty one days for sale by public outcry, on the third day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy nine, did then, openly and publicly, and according to the custom of auction, sell and dispose of the said tract of land, below described, unto O P Mills for three hundred and fifty Dollars being at that price, the highest bidder for the same. Now, know all men that the said S J Douthit Master as aforesaid in consideration of the premiums, and also in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and fifteen Dollars, paid me by the said O P Mills the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said O P Mills and his heirs and assigns, all that tract of land, situate lying and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, beginning at a high rock 3 x 3 x n.m. on the white horse road thence 803<sup>1/2</sup> W 35, 80 to a stone 3 x 3 x n.m. thence S 77<sup>1/2</sup> E 16, 72 to a P. O. 3 x 3 x n.m. thence W 33<sup>1/2</sup> S 61, 76 to a stone 3 x 3 x n.m. thence S 77<sup>1/2</sup> E 15, 50 to a stone 3 x 0 m. thence N 11<sup>1/2</sup> E 2, 60 to a stone 3 x n.m. in said road, thence along said road N 45<sup>1/2</sup> W 26, 64 to the beginning corner, adjoining lands of Mrs Dixie Dean, Salem Lohr and others and containing fifty four and a half acres more or less together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract of land belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the reversion and remainder, rents issues, and profits thereof, and also all the estate, right, title, interest, dower, possession, property, benefit, claim and demand whatsoever, both at law and in equity, of the said Aaron Thompson deceased and of all the parties to the said suit, and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof, by, from or under them, or either of them, to have and to hold the said tract of land with its hereditaments, privileges and appurtenances, unto the said O P Mills his heirs and assigns, for ever.
