 I, O P Mills, do know all men by these presents, that I, O P Mills, of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Sixty-five Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by Lavinia Crosswell in the State aforesaid and the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Lavinia Crosswell all that piece parcel and tract of land situated lying and being in the State and County aforesaid and about one and a quarter miles from Greenville Court House, on a street running South from the Augusta Road between William Wilkins and H P Hammett's land beginning at a stake on said street, the same being the corner of Robt Coxs lot and running with said street "to the branch," South 67 1/4 West to stone thence across the Branch South 2 3/4 West 3 30 with said street to a stone on William Wilkins line, thence with William Wilkins line, North 84 1/2 East 2 57 course the branch to a stone on Robt Coxs corner, thence with Robt Coxs line North 5 1/2 West 3 16 to the beginning corner on said street containing two thirds of an acre more or less together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or pertaining. To have and to hold all and singular its, said premises before mentioned unto the said Lavinia Crosswell her heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself and my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Lavinia Crosswell, her heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs or any other lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
