and release unto the said Isaac Kelly all my interest in
a certain tract piece or lot of land (the same being one undivided half) and known as the Belvoir Grish mill tract,
Beginning on a Persimmon on the road leading from Bishop
Bishop's W. the said mill thence N.W. & across the creek 68 poles
to a W. C. thence S. 89 E. 88 poles to a Spanish Oak on D.R.
Pools line thence S. 7 W. 34 poles to a Black Oak on the road

road to the persimmon the beginning corner on said
