the City of Greenville of
Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, in consideration
of Twelve Dollars to us paid by Augusta L. Davis of Gre-
enville County, in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained
sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain
sell and release, unto the said, Augusta L. Davis all that
certain piece or lot of land situate, lying and being in the
corporate limits of the City of Greenville, in the State and
County aforesaid, within the enclosure known as "Spring-
wood Cemetery" and described in Plat of said Cemetery
made by G. L. Norman as lot No 64, to which Plat
reference is hereby directed for a more particular
description of the same. Together with all and singular
the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to
the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or
appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular
the premises before mentioned, unto the said Augusta L.
Davis her heirs and assigns forever. And we do hereby
bind ourselves and our successors in office to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the said premises,
unto the said Augusta L. Davis her heirs and assigns,
against ourselves, our successors and every other person
whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any
part thereof.

Station on the waters of Tyger River, containing 71 acres
more or less situate in Greenville County in said
State. Together with all and singular the rights
members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
premises belonging or in any wise incident or appen-
taining. To have & to hold all & singular the said pre-
mises into the said Martin J. Dillard his heirs & assigns
forever. I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors
& administrators to warrant & forever defend all and singu-
lar the said premises unto the said Martin J. Dillard
his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs
and against every other person or persons who-
msoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
or any part thereof.
