 To Deed | Know all men by these presents,
 Eliza Phillips | That I Mahaly B. Garrison of
 Greenville County in the state
 aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred
 Dollars to me paid by Eliza Phillips of the County of
 Greenville in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained
 sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain
 sell and release unto the said Eliza Phillips all that piece
 parcel and tract of land supposed to contain seventy five
 and one half acres, more or less, situate lying and being
 in the County and State aforesaid on waters of Brushy Creek
 branch waters of Conestee River, and has the following metes and
 bounds, viz: Beginning at a Post Oak 3x cub down in a hedge
 row and running thence S 53 E 45° to a stone & in said hedge
 row on the old line, thence N 80° E 38.70 with Mc Carter's line to
 a stone 3x on Hattiglaw's line, thence N 27° E with Hattiglaw's line
 to a conditional corner made by said Garrison and Hattiglaw,
 thence a conditional line made by the same parties to the Brushy
 Creek Road, thence along said road as a line to a stone 3x on
 Stephen Phillips' line, thence with said line S 37 W 18.50 to a
 pine 3x, thence N 88 1/2 W 31.40 to a small Red oak 3x on Joseph
 Edwards' line, thence S 10° E 6.00 to a Post Oak 3x, thence
 45° E 9.25 to the beginning corner, bounded by lands of James
 Mc Carter, Ethel Hattiglaw, and others, Together with all and
 singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenan-
 ces to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or
 appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises
 before mentioned unto the said Eliza Phillips her heirs and
 assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs
 executors, and administrators, to warrant and forever defend
 all and singular the said premises unto the said Eliza Phillips
 her heirs and assigns, against all and any heirs and all other
 persons lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any
 part thereof.

 W 3.87 to a stone 3x 0m thence S 45 1/2 W 28.00 to a stone 3x 0m
 in a branch, thence S 71 1/4 W 4.50 to a stone 3x 0m thence S
 80 1/4 E 5.50 to a pine 3x 0m down, thence N 12 E 23.80 to a Post
 Oak 3x dead, N 67 1/4 E 11.00 to a cherry tree 3x 0m thence
 N 29 1/2 W 17.20 to a stone 3x 0m thence S 82 1/2 W 8.10 to a pine 3x
 0m, thence N 73 1/2 W 5.84 to a stone 3x 0m thence S 64 1/2 W 7.40
