paid by J. M. Wham in the State aforesaid, have granted  
bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant  
bargain sell and release, unto the said J. M. Wham all  
that piece parcel or tract of land lying on Little Reedy  
Fork waters of Reedy River and being in Oak Lawn  
Township County and State aforesaid containing  
Twenty-four and one half acres more or less and  
better known as the Rice mill place beginning at a  
stone thence N 87 1/2 W 9.86 to a stone S 7 1/2 W  
14.00 to a stone S 7 1/2 W 8.44 E 10.70 to a stone S 7  
thence N 54 1/4 E 21.86 to a Poplar S 7 on creek thence N 32 1/4  
W 6.95 to the beginning. Together with all and singular  
the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances  
to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident  
or appertaining. To have and to hold, all and singular  
the said premises before mentioned unto the said J. M.  
Wham his heirs and assigns forever, and I do  
hereby bind myself and my heirs executors, and administra-  
tors to warrant and forever defend all and singular  
the said premises unto the said J. M. Wham heirs and  
assigns, against me and my heirs or any other person or  
persons whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the  
same, or any part thereof.

consideration of the sum of one hundred and seventy  
five dollars to me in hand paid at and before the  
sealing of these presents, by Nancy Ann Ross in the  
State aforesaid County of Greenville (the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted  
bargained sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said  
Nancy Ann Ross a certain tract or parcel of land  
lying and being in said State and County and situated  
between creek waters of Beaver dam Creek waters of middle  
Tyger River unto the said Nancy Ann Ross her heirs  
and assigns and beginning over Red Oak Run  
mountain the corner of the Clayton grant thence
