Whereas we the  
day of A. D. 1877  
Whittier Symmes  
Plaintiff exhibited  
his Complaint for Relief &c in the Court  
of Common Pleas for the County of Greenville  
against Whittier Symmes and Thomas  
L. Gaver as Trustees and other defendants  
wherein amongst other things it was alleged  
that the Plaintiff Whittier Symmes was  
entitled to a one-fifth interest in the lands  
previously conveyed by William A. McDonald  
 Clerk of said Court to Thomas L. Gaver  
and Whittier Symmes Trustees and  
whereas upon the said cause being heard  
at the April Term of the Court of Common  
Pleas for Greenville County fol-  
lowing to the term A. D. 1879 it was

on the 17 day of July A. D. 1879 among other things  
ordered that Thomas L. Gaver & Whittier Symmes Trustees,  
do sell at public outcry after af-  
ter due advertisement the lots of land mentioned in  
the Trust Deed aforesaid previously made there, and  
whence by virtue of the power conferred upon them  
in and by the order aforesaid and in pursuance of  
order as directed by said order, after having duly ad-  
vertised the lot or parcel of land herein after described for  
sale by public outcry on the 6 day of December in  
the year of our Lord one thousand Eighty-four and  
Eighty-the said Trustees did then openly and publi-  
cally sell and dispose of said lot or parcel of land  
before described unto R. F. Gorless for One hun-  
red and forty Dollars, being at that price the  
highest bid for the same. Now therefore, Whereas  
all now by these presents that we Thomas L.  
Gaver and Whittier Symmes Trustees, as aforesaid  
by virtue of the power conferred upon us  
by the order aforesaid in consideration of the  
sum of Five Hundred Forty Dollars

to us paid by R. F. Gorless before the delivery  
of these presents have granted bargained sold  
and released all by these presents do grant  
bargain sell and release unto the said R.  
F. Gorless all that piece braced or lot of  
lands being a parcel of the lands above all-  
uded to situated as aforesaid in the County  
of Greenville and State aforesaid & com-  
mencing at a Stake on Lower Street run-  
ning thence S. 28 $\frac{1}{2}$  E Three hundred and twenty  
two feet to stake, thence 016 W one hundred  
and one feet and one half of one foot to  
stake, thence S. 14 $\frac{1}{2}$  E one hundred fifty two  
feet and one half one foot to stake corner.  
Lot in 61. Section No 28 $\frac{1}{2}$  E One hundred &  
Eighteen feet to stake on Lower Street then  
along said street N. 61 $\frac{1}{2}$  W Four hundred and  
one feet to the beginning corner and an  
adjoining to lot 61. S. 14 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 158 feet
