set over and by these presents does bargain and
agree, transfer and set forth over unto the
party of the second part, all that personal
estate merchandise debts books of account
bills receivable, promissory notes, money due,
demands and assets of every nature herein
and description whatever belonging or due
to the party of the first part where ever the
same may be, in trust nevertheless for the
following uses and purposes, 1st to pay
said personal estate and merchandise either
at public or private sale in such manner
as he may deem most advantageous to the
creditors of the party of the first part and
to collect all the debts, demands &c. which
are or may be due the party of the first part
2nd To pay all the expenses of this assign-
ment including a fee of twenty five dollars
to Mr. L. P. Moultrie for legal services in some

preparing this Deed of Assignment 3rd To pay Thomas W.
Davis one hundred and eighty three and seven Dollars,
4th To pay Charles Drach & Co. three hundred and 78/100
Dollars, 5th To pay each of my other creditors as shall have
their claims within Sixty days from this date, and shall
execute a release therefor in full hundred dollar if these shall
not be enough to pay the last claim in full they shall
be paid pro rata and in proportion moreover if either the
party of the first part who may tend
