Opinion of Prestfield of Administrators of the Estate of John T. Blanche deceased, was on about the 20th day of April in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and eighteen for the purpose of procuring a written acknowledgment of the said deceased having made known her complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County of Greenwich against George Prestfield, John C. Prestfield Thomas M. C. T. Blanche & Master & Doutch, Esq. State and H. R. Marshall, demanding payment in relation to the Real Estate herein after mentioned and delivered the cause being at issue cause to be heard on the 13th day of December 1880 and such proceedings were had therein as aforesaid and a Decree of the said court whereby it was adjudged and ordered that the said Real Estate herein after mentioned be sold by S. J. Doutch Master his agent for the County of Greenwich on the terms aforesaid for the purpose mentioned in the said Decree as by reference thereto can be seen in said Court will appear and the said Master after having duly advertised the said Real Estate for sale by public notice on the seventh day of February in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and eighty one did so do openly and publicly and according to the customs of Auctioneers sell and dispose of the sum of Six hundred and thirty six dollars being at that price the highest bid in there now therefore I now do give my left hand promise that I S. J. Doutch Master his agent for the County of Greenwich aforesaid his Agent at

the sum of Six hundred and thirty six dollars to the said Sister Vance Esq. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have granted bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Sister Vance Esq. all that piece of land situated lying and being within the corporate limits of the City of Greenwich, in the County of Greenwich bearing at a stake on River Road, Greenwich 81 a. 18 r. 8 - To a stake on right of way (ten feet wide) thence with said right of way N. 76° 17' 19" to a stake thence with said road S. 189° to a stake on River Road thence with said road S. 82° 01' 42" to the beginning corner adjoining lots No. 44 and 42 and South place containing twenty eight acres more or less and River Road as tenth No. 42, is the division of the Real Estate of John Prestfield deceased together with all areas occupied the rights, boundaries, inheritances and appurtenances to the said premises being, or in anywise incident or appertaining, and all the estate right title claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid and of each of them is due to the same and of all other persons rightfully claiming from under or by these or any thereof to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Sister Vance Esq. her heirs and assigns forever, in witness whereof, I the said Master his agent for the County of Greenwich under and by virtue of the aforesaid Decree have hereunto set my hand and seal this seventh day of February in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and eighty one and given my left hand promise to the said Sister Vance Esq. the hundred and fifth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
