Treasurer of said Southern Baptist Theological  
Seminary being then duly authorized has here-  
unto set his hand and affixed the seal of said  
Corporation this 12th day of January in  
the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred  
and eighty one and also in the one hundred and fifth  
year of the sovereignty and independence of the  
United States of America.

Whereas the Board of the Southern Baptist Theological  
Seminary at and of its various sessions, authorized Rev.  
James P. Boyce, its Treasurer, to sell and make titles to

is hereby duly authorized to make titles to all  
lands hereby or hereafter sold in South Carolina  
and in any other of the States or Territories of the  
United States, and to use the seal of the said Se-  
minary in the execution thereof. Resolved, that the  
Secretary of the Board be and is hereby directed to  
furnish the said James P. Boyce, Treasurer with  
such certificate or certificates of this action of the  
Board as may be necessary.
