 Birnie and others defendants, whose's aumpt
 other things it was alleged that said John Westfield
 now deceased on the day of A.D. 1873 over
 and conveyed to the Plaintiff Whither Symmes and
 Thomas M. G. Lower the defendants
 and to one James Birnie also now deceased all
 undivided four (4-5) eight parts interest his ays to certain
 Real Estate in and around the City of Greenville
 in the County & State of South Carolina more particularly
 described in the Deed of Conveyance of that
 date now on the 30th day of September A.D. 1873 to
 said John Westfield & agreed to pass to the heirs of
 said Birnie & co. which was composed of himself
 and other parties last above named certain certain
 Lots, pieces or parcels of land his ays near the
 said City of Greenville & County and State aforesaid
 said ays were particularly described in said
 agreement and that the said parties who were
 interested in the lands above mentioned for and
 to facilitate the said ays transfer of said lands
 had agreed to also amongst themselves to
 Convey all of the said lands his trust to two of
 them numbered to sell and divide the proceeds
 of sale among the heirs according to their
 respective interests and to make a

 trust deed that a suitable Trustee be appointed together
 with some suitable person or persons to act as Trustees or Trustees

 trust as set forth and delivered in the Deed reported by the
 said Referee and whereas the said William A. McElveen Clerk
 as aforesaid did convey the lands mentioned in
 the pleading to the said Trustees, now therefore
 all now by these presents I that we Thomas G. Lower
 and Whither Symmes Trustees, as aforesaid by virtue
 of the power Conferred upon us as and by the order
 and trust Deed aforesaid upon the written request
 of the Cestuis Que trust herein made and in
 performance of our duty as such Trustees doo
 also in Consideration of the sum of Twenty Five
 Dollars to us paid by Mrs Sallie M. Lower before
 the delivery of these presents have granted bargained
 sold and released all by these presents as grant
 bargain and release made the said Mrs
 Sallie M. Lower all that piece parcel or Lot of
 land being parcels of the lands aforesaid mentioned
 situated lying in the City and County of Greenville
 in the State aforesaid commencing at a
 stake on Birnie Street North West corner of lot
 formerly held by Weston Dickson running thence
 828 1/2 feet hundred and Seventeen feet ays
 half of ays foot to stile on Birnie Lot Line thence
 86 1/2 to fifty feet to Dickson Lot thence N. 28 1/2 E
 Two hundred and seventeen feet ays and half of ays
 back along Dickson line back to stile on Birnie Line
