Gower	The State of South Carolina To all to whom these presents shall come; I Perry D Gilbreath Sheriff of Greenville County, and State aforesaid, send greeting: Whereas, by virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the County of Greenville, tested the fifth day of December in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and eighty one, at the said Court of Common Pleas, and
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directed, commanding me that of the goods and  
chattels, lands and tenements of J. B. Gower to levy the  
sum of One hundred and eighty one <sup>73</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Dollars  
damages and costs. I have seized and taken of the  
lands and tenements of the said J. B. Gower a certain

of the Statute in such case made and provided, and  
for and in consideration of the said sum of

acknowledge, have granted bargained and  
sold, and by these presents do grant bargain  
and sell unto the said Sallie M. Gower, her

said J. B. Gower of right had, has and to the  
same; do have and to hold the said piece  
parcel and tract of land, with its appurtenan-  
ces, unto the said Sallie M. Gower, her  
heirs and assigns forever, as fully and  
absolutely, and the said Perry D. Gilbreath  
might could, as might be
