 16th day of Sept in the
 year of our Lord One
 thousand eight hundred and eighty one between
 D. D. Moore and Eliza J. Moore the wife of D. D.
 Moore of the County of Anderson and State aforesaid
 of the one part and Clark Johnson David
 Moore Lewis Austin Trustees in trust for the
 uses and purposes hereinafter mentioned all of
 the following lot or lots of land in the State and
 County aforesaid of the other part witnesseth
 that the said D. D. Moore & Eliza J. Moore for and
 in consideration of the sum of one dollar specie
 to us in hand paid have given granted bargained
 sold released confirmed & conveyed and by these
 presents do give grant bargain sell release
 confirm & convey unto them the said Clark Johnson
 David Moore & Lewis Austin and their successors
 Trustees in trust for the uses and purposes here-
 inafter mentioned and declared all of a certain
 lot of land in the State aforesaid & County of
 Greenville containing one acre on the Robin
 Avery tract out off the line next to Mrs. Stacey
 Chapman's land immediately on the border of
 said Robin Avery place and line dividing
 said tract from the estate of Mrs. Stacey, Abi-

beginning on said line above named near midway
 between the two corners of the said line now occupi-
 ed by a church of the Methodist Church trustees
 yards East of said house at right angles to this
 line 70 yards North stoke x 111 thence 70 yards back
 to the said line dividing this place from the estate
 of Mrs. Stacey Chapman. Together with all or singular
 the rights privileges and appurtenances thereto belong-
 ing or in anyway or wise appertaining to have and
 to hold all and singular the above named one
 acre lot or piece of land situate lying and being
 as aforesaid unto them the said Trustees and
 their successors in office for the Methodist Epis-
 copal Church forever in trust that they the trustees
 shall erect and build or cause to be erected and
 build thereon a house or place of worship for
 the use of the Methodist Episcopal Church and
 they shall at all times forever hereafter permit
 such ministers and preachers belonging to the
 said church, as shall from time to time be duly
 authorized by the General Conferences of the minis-
 teres and preachers of the said Methodist E.
 Church or by the annual conferences authorized
 by the said General Conference to preach and
 expound God's holy word therein and the
 said D. D. Moore and Eliza J. Moore do by
 these presents forever relinquish and convey
 all or singular the before mentioned and descri-
 bed lot or piece of land with the appurtenances
 thereto belonging unto them the said Trustees
 and their successors chosen and appointed as
 aforesaid from the claims or claims of them
 the said grantors their heirs and assigns from
 any other claim and should they ever fail to
 be kept up a church on said lot the grantors
 reserve the place as if never granted for
 such purpose. This lot shall not be used
 for any purpose except a church lot or
 school house.
