Doutchit Probate Judge of Greenville County in the State aforesaid and Charles W Stokes Administrator of the Estate of John J Stokes, deceased, on about the 17th day of September in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and eighty exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid against S Henry Stokes, Hawley Sullivan, William H Stokes, Thaddeus C Stokes, Almon H Stokes, Robert Lee Stokes, Eugene Stokes and Henry Stokes demanding judgment in relation to the real estate herein after mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 12th day of November 1880 and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decetal order of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decided that the said Real Estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by S. J. Doutchit master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Fourteen hundred and ten Dollars, to me paid by the said Emma L Austin whereof is hereby acknowledged

and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Emma L Austin all that tract of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, on both sides of Laurel Creek, adjoining lands of Dr. S. M. Hunter, J. W. Stokes and tract No 2 and 5. Beginning at a stone 3x3x m. thence N 57° E 11.60 to a stone 3x. thence N 14° 46' E 1 to a stone 3x. 5. thence N 65° E 9 to a stone 3x. 5. thence ^{thus} N 11° W 17.50 to a stone 3x. 3x. 24. thence S 78° W 28.00 to a stone 3x. 3x. m. thence S 88° W 10 to a stone 3x. 3x. per prnc 3x m. thence S 33° 12' W 25.00 to a stone 3x. 3x. m. thence S 19.88 to the beginning corner and containing one, hundred and eight and a fourth acres more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, claims and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them, in and to the same, and of all other persons rightfully claiming from under, or by these or any of them.
