Cox of Greenville County in the state aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by Thomas P. Young in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release, unto the said Thomas P. Young all that certain piece parcel and tract of land con- taining one hundred acres more or less, situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, six and a half miles from Greenville Court House on the West side of the Grove Road, and adjoining land of Capt J. M. Mc- Nabb and Cleveland. Beginning at a stone 3x on the Grove Road and running thence N 79 1/2 W 48 60' chs to a stone 3x m m in a road on left McNabb's line thence with said road S 45 1/2 E 100' to a stone 3x m m in a road on right McNabb's line thence with said road E 45 1/2
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S 45 1/2 chs to a stone 3x m m in the Grove Road thence N
S 1 1/2 W 1 1/2 chs to the beginning, with said road as a
line. Together with all and singular the rights,
members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
premises belonging, or in anywise incident or app-
pertaining. To have and to hold all and singular
the said premises before mentioned unto the said
Thomas P. Young his heirs and assigns forever,
and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and
administrators, to warrant and forever defend
all and singular the said premises unto the said
