Co. S. Deed.

J. A. Ashmore I know all now by these presents
that the Commissioners of the District Board by virtue
of authority conferred by the acts of the General As-
sembly of the said state, in consideration of the
sum of One Thousand and Forty Dollars, paid by
J. A. Ashmore of Greenville County in the State of South
Carolina, have granted, bargained and sold unto us
and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and
release, unto the said J. A. Ashmore all the right title
interest and estate of the State of South Carolina in
and to the following lands, to wit Sixty acres more
or less situate in the County of Greenville State aforesaid
said being a lot of the M. T. Street and having such
shape and form as are represented by a plat on record
in the Office of the Secretary of State.

So further with all and singular the right, title, fees
hereditaments, and appurtenances both main prem-
ises belonging, or in any wise in said lot or appertaining
to so how land to have all and singular the premises so
fore mentioned unto the said J. A. Ashmore his heirs
and assigns forever.

such parcel and lot of land situate lying and
being just out side of the corporate limits of the City
of Greenville on Pickney Street near the air Line Depot
and having the following Metres and boundaries to wit:
Beginning at a Stake on said Pickney Street and
running thence N. 35° 1/4 W. 315.0 ft to a Stake thence S. 54° 1/4
