do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Sallie M. Green all that tract of land situateing
and lying in the County and State aforesaid
about three miles from Greenville Court House on
the Plank road containing one hundred and
fifty acres or less, being that portion of the
tract conveyed to me by the heirs of William
Sibley deceased, which is left after the sale of fifty
acres of the same by me to Eliza T. Price
etc. also all that tract of land, situateing
and lying in the county and state aforesaid, on the
West side of the road above mentioned, adjoining
the above described tract and containing thirty
two acres more or less, being the same tract
of land conveyed to me by C. Earle, J. J. Eagle and
H. Maxwell Executors of the estate of Mr. W.
Price deceased, by deed bearing date the
first day of October, Eighteen Hundred and Seventy five
together with all and singular the rights members, hereditament
and appurtenance, to the said premises belonging
or in anywise incident or appertaining thereto
and to hold, all and singular the said prem-
ises before mentioned, unto the said Sallie M.
Green her heirs and assigns forever. And I
do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and
administrators to warrant and defend
all and singular the said premises unto the
said Sallie M. Green her heirs and assigns
against me and my heirs and every other person
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the
