Donaldson of the land herein after described and Conveyed - and Whereas affection his said Plaintiff to said Deed, on account of real or supposed defects and irregularities, and the unwilling and determined to remove all such affections and to confirm the Deed of Conveyance then made, and cure all defects therein, Now therefore: Know all men by these presents that Mr. Alexander Mcbee of the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina, and Horday P. Mcbee of the town of Lincolnton in the State of North Carolina Executors of the Will of Horday Mcbee deceased, and by virtue of an Order of the Court of Common Pleas in the case of Horday P. Mcbee and Alexander Mcbee vs. Malinda P. Mcbee et al - reciting date 16th day of May 1872, and in consideration of four hundred and sixteen dollars to his Plaintiff and before the sealing of these presents by J. D. Donaldson of Greenville County in the State aforesaid. (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. D. Donaldson all that piece of ground or tract of land, situate, lying and being about two Miles from the City of Greenville on the Augusta Road in the County of Greenville, and in the State of North Carolina, and having the following lines, metes and bounds to wit: Beginning on a Black Oak, Stake old corner on the left side of said Augusta Rd. and runs thence S 19[°] E 13[°] to a Rock corner thence S 13[°] E 12[°] to a Stake S. thence S 73[°] E 9[°] 46' to a small pine tree S 19[°] E 21[°] to a Stake on the right side of said Augusta Rd. thence south 57[°] to a Rock corner on the
