And it is agreed that
of every part should be clear and unencumbered, or if defaced
shall be rendered property of the Government he will retain
one thousand dollars and no cents, and in consideration
of the receipt of the said party of the second part
that he shall be remunerated for the said party of the first
part, his heirs or assigns to render the said promises
and to pay to all persons thereof, And the said
party of the second part does hereby covenant to pay
to the said party of the first part the said amount
as heretofore specified, And that at the expiration of the
said term, the said party of the second part will quit
and deliver the said promises, heretofore delivered, in as
good state and condition as reasonably may be
permitted, And the party of the second part
does hereby further covenant to make such repairs
upon said promises from time to time as may be necessary
to keep said promises in good repair and not
to cut any green timber on said place except as may
be necessary for use in such repairs; and not to
cut green timber for fence wood, And the said party
of the first part does also covenant that the said
party of the second part on paying the said party
rent, and performing the covenants aforesaid shall
and may peaceably and quietly have, hold and
enjoy the said leasehold premises for the term aforesaid
