presents shall come:  
I Hamlin Beattie, at the

County of Greenville in the State aforesaid, as receiver  
of the Camperdon Mills: send Greeting:  
Whereas at a term of the Circuit Court of the said State  
held at Greenville Court House in said State on  
the 8<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1885, in an action pending  
in said Court in which, Charles J. Hubbard and others  
were plaintiffs and the Camperdon Mills and others were  
defendants, the Honorable P. C. Presley one of the judges  
of said Court made a decree in which amongst other  
things it was ordered that said Hamlin Beattie as  
Receiver, as aforesaid, sell all of the machinery, &c. with  
the leases, and all the rights, powers, privileges, and fran-  
chises belonging to or appertaining to the said Camperdon

Beattie as Receiver as aforesaid in order to carry into  
effect to sell so made by me as aforesaid, in pursuance  
of said Decree of said Court, and also in consideration  
of the premises and of the said sum of Twenty thousand  
Dollars (\$20,000) so bid as aforesaid being first paid  
or secured to be paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
to have granted, bargained, sold, released, conveyed assigned
