The State of South Carolina Knows all Men by these presents that whereas George Green late of Greenville County and State aforesaid departed this life intestate and unincumbered in the year 1868 being and possessed of his tracts of land and containing 101 Acres and the other 96 Acres in all 197 Acres which have since remained in the possession of his widow (Delila Green) and whereas the said George Green (decd) left surviving him as his heirs at law and distributees his widow (Delila Green) and eight children to wit Daniel McGreen James Green Cornelia Bridwell Mary Priestly Wm Green Wm Green T. K. Dickson Survey made the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of December 1884 containing twenty Acres more or less bounded as by a plat hereunto attached. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances hereunto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Green his heirs and assigns forever And we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs executors and Administrators W. Warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James Green his heirs and assigns against us and our heirs and against every other person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same on any part thereof.
