R. Y. Hellams Know all men by these Presents, That I E. M. Holliday of Greenville County in the State ofesaid in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and Seventy five Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by R. Y. Hellams of the County and in the State ofesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged & shall granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do Grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R. Y. Hellams All that piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying & being in Greenville County & in the State ofesaid, on Saluda River, containing Ninety seven Acres, more or less adjoining lands of Hellams & Gray & E. H. Holliday being my half of the tract of land left me by the will of my father Robert Holliday and being the place I now live on. Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining I Have and to Hold, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said R. Y. Hellams and his Heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself & my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said R. Y. Hellams His Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
