G. & L. R. R. Co. Know all Men by these Presents,

That I, Caroline J. S. Burdett of said County in
 the State of South Carolina, in consideration of the sum
 of One hundred (\$100.) Dollars, to me in hand
 paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by the
 Greenville and Laurens Railroad Company in
 the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
 knowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and
 released and by these presents do grant, bargain
 sell and release unto the said Greenville and
 Laurens Railroad Company a right of way forty
 nine feet wide, that is to say, Twenty two and one
 half feet on each side of the center of the track of
 said Railroads as at present constructed, through
 my land, situated about seven and three quarters
 miles from Greenville Court House in said County
 and state, beginning in the line of Riley E. Cox on
 the N. East End, and ending in the line of Mrs. Mary
 P. Robertson on the S. East R. Together with all and
 singular the Rights, Liberties, Blemishments and
 Appartances to the said Premises belonging,
 to be otherwise incident or pertaining.
 To
 have and to hold all and singular the said
 premises before mentioned unto the said Greenville and Laurens Rail-
 road Company, its successors and assigns forever. And I do
 hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and
 Administrators, to warrant and defend de-
 fend all and singular the said premises
 unto the said Greenville and Laurens Rail-
 road Company its successors and assigns,
 against me and my Heirs, and all other persons
 lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any
 part thereof. Witness my hand and Seal this
 seventh day of August in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and eighty
 six, and in the one hundred and eleventh
 year of the Sovereignty and Independence of
 United States of America.
