Cannon, Chmn of Board of Trustees of Fountain Inn Highschool and his successors in office the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. A. Cannon and successors forever, for the sole use and benefit of said Highschool, a lot of land in the town of Fountain Inn, S.C., beginning on the South East line of W. B. Parsons lot purchase of Cannon & West, numbered in place of J. R. Hollams and running thence N. 83 E. 4.66 to a stone x, thence S. 26 E. 9.34 to stone x, thence S. 49 1/4 W. 44.50 to stone x, thence N. 26 W. 6.00 to beginning stone x as set forth by a plat of survey made by G. L. Anderson Sept 17th, 1886, and containing two acres and one twentieth of an acre, bounded by lands of said J. R. Owings and S. B. Knight and lands of W. B. Parsons and Cannon & West. And we expressly reserve a right-of-way of forty feet on each side of said lot as indicated by dotted lines on Plat, Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Dedicaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or pertaining to have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said J.
