C (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Eli Moore all that certain piece of land lying and being in the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, on the North side of the Spartanburg Road, and about one mile from the Court House and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a Red Oak on the North side of the Spartanburg road, thence N. 44 E. 130 chs. to a stake on the side-walk; thence N. 76 W. 417 chs. to a stake on the Street; thence S. 72 W. 3.08 chs. to a stake on Street; thence S. 20 E. 174 chs. to a stake on said Street; thence S. 29 E. 3.21 chs. to the beginning retrace, the same being bounded on the South by the short granite fence, on the East by Allen's, on the North by some of Mr. Jones and on the West by Street. The same lot divided to Donald M. McRae, by George Jones, G. E. Jones, and Emily A. Jones on the 28th day of May 1880, and by Donald M. McRae to Julius C. Smith on the 13th March 1885.
