Main Street towards the Public Square, Seventy-Eight feet to an iron post in
the line of the west side of Main Street one thousand and fifty feet from
Broad Street; thence from the two points above indicated on two lines
running with right angles with main street parallel with Broad
Street and with each other, one hundred and ten feet to a
shaft back line which runs parallel with Main Street and
is Seventy-Eight feet in length; as will appear by Plat hereto
joined and indorsed.
