Goodwin all that certain tract of land or lot of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid Beginning at a Stake on Chee Cut Road thence S 64° 46' E 9.00 to the head of a ditch through a mulberry tree thence S 34° 6' E 20 to a bend in said ditch thence S 10° W 20 to a bend in said ditch thence S 21° 45' E 40 to a bend in said ditch thence S 54° 12' W 16.5 to a cut gum on bank of said ditch (It is hereby intended to give me and my heirs of said ditch from head to said tree), thence N 85° 1/2 W 7.75 to a stake thence N 91° E 10 to a stake on said Road thence E 80° 1/2 E 6.50 with said Road to the beginning corner being a part of Lot no. 54 in the division of the Real Estate of Mrs Westfield deceased and containing 13 acres more or less and more particularly described in a Plan by W.
