Bailey, thirty feet front on

Trade Street in the Town, County and State before mentioned and running back sixty feet said lot of land beginning at a corner of Mrs. C. C. Walker's line on Trade Street and running North West with said Trade Street thirty feet thence back sixty feet to a stone or thence back to the Walker line. Thence S. E. thence with the Walker line sixty feet to the beginning corner on Trade Street. This lot of land was deeded some eight years ago to W. D. Wolf by Cunningham Pinnington and thence deeded to Noah Cannon by W. D. Wolf (which deeds have never been lost or misplaced and having been lost or misplaced and by common consent it is now deeded to W. D. Bailey by Cunningham Pinnington and the said W. D.
