the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO  
HEREBY, bargain, sell and release unto the said Tammie P. Beattie all that tract of land situate lying  
in said County in the State aforesaid containing six acres more or less being about five and a half miles from the city of  
Greenville, this being the tract conveyed to me by John M. Eastwell on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of January A.D. 1887  
by this all that certain tract of land situate in the County of Greenville State aforesaid about  
one and a half miles from the city of Greenville on the Augusta road known as the Rebecca Lowell place  
on both sides of the Augusta road and said to contain five acres more or less bounded by estate lands  
of Mrs Mary E. Lowell, deceased &c. &c. &c. others also all that other tract of land situate lying  
in said County in the State on both sides of the said Augusta road about five and a half miles below the  
city of Greenville lately purchased by Mary E. Linderman from James W. Chapman &c. &c. and to contain  
about one half acre more or less bounded by the estate lands of the said Mary E. Lowell deceased &c.  
belonging to the estate of the late James W. Chapman &c. &c. others; these two last described  
tracts having been conveyed to me by Mary W. Linderman by her deed dated the 3d  
January A.D. 1887.
