Dickson of said County and State (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said D. C. Dickson all that tract or lot of land situated lying and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid in land known as South Upper Alles and known as the Charles corner tract bounded by Lands of Dell Holly, Colmar and others beginning at a Dogwood & Dell corner running thence N 17 W 29 4.0 to a red Oak & thence 0 62 E 5.8 to a stone or thence N 30 W 1.0 10 to a stone & thence 0 43 W 5.26 to a Red Oak dead thence 0 41 E 0 11.50 to a Sour Wood thence N 43 W 8.00 to a Spanish Oak or on the Branch thence up said branch with the meandering of the same about 26 chains to a Holly at the head of the Branch thence 0 49 E 7.70 to a Post Oak & thence 0 56 E 2.00 to the Side Road thence with the said Road about 47.00 to a Red Oak stump John Holly corner thence N 47 E 3.70 to a stake in and old field thence 0 57 E 5.50 to a Stake in a hollow thence N 47 E 14.60 to a white Oak & thence N 13 E 6.81 to the Beginning corner containing one hundred and forty six acres more or less.
