W. Clark's line running on the North West bounded by John Clarke's land beginning on a stone corner on the East side of Mathews creek on John Clarke's line thence west along said Clark's line to Rock thence along said line on the main top of the ridge till it strikes the Galedard land thence East a long the gillanard line to a stake thence down South East corners along joining Hagwood line to Mathew's creek thence down the meanders of said creek to the beginning.
