Carolina, beginning at corner of the lot of Thos. C. Martley, on the south
side of Washington Street running thence along Washington Street in a south
easterly direction sixty seven feet thence in a south western direction one
hundred and ninety two $\frac{1}{4}$ feet to Mallett's line thence along Mallett's line
in a Northwest direction seventy nine $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to line of Thos. C. Martley
thence in a north easterly direction one hundred and ninety five $\frac{1}{2}$ feet
