said on the North side of Court Street East of Main Beginning at the cor-
ner of J. W. Fields lot thence in a Northwesterly direction along the line of said
Field One hundred and twenty feet to the Land sold by Mrs. Galle J.
Castle to J. R. Houston thence in a Westerly direction along said land -
lity feet thence in a Southerly direction along the Land of Mrs.
Soakes One hundred and twenty feet to Court Street, thence along Court Street
Sixty feet in an Easterly direction to the beginning corner The said
