Brissay (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said William M. Brissay all that certain piece of land and tract of land containing six tenth of an acre more or less situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid in the South Western part of the City of Greenville on the West side of Anderson Street and having the following lines, mites and courses viz: Beginning at a stake or corn on said street Octons corner running thence N 76 1/4 W 107 feet to a stake on Gully or ditch Thence along the East side of said ditch 172 feet to a stake on the Old M. Pearson line. Thence with said line N 76 1/4 E 100 feet to a Stake or corn in Anderson Street. Thence along said street N 19 E 175 feet to the beginning corner.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
