Hammond all that piece or lot of land situate lying and being on the north east corner of Stone Avenue & Carlton Street in the city of Greenville Beginning at a stake on said corner, running with Stone Avenue 6 84 1/2 E 131 feet to a stake thence 7 1/2 E 200 feet to a line of Mountain City Land Improvement Co. Thence with said line N 84 1/2 W 131 feet to a stake on Wilson Street. Thence along with said line S 50 1/2 W 200 feet to the beginning corner and containing 40 1/2 acres more or less and known as lot No. 9 map 4 of Stone Lands Recorded in Vol V. U page 542 office of R. M.
