land situate lying and being in the county and State aforesaid adjoining lands of G. C. Baker, Lewis Suddeth (deceased) and bounded on the North side by Brushy Creek, waters of Enoree River. Containing Sixty acres more or less. Beginning at a corner on a cluster of maples on the South side of Brushy Creek and running thence S 34 E 22 15 Ch to Black Oak tree thence N 63 1/2 W 13 40 Ch to Plum bush on bank of gully, on thence N 59 1/2 W 17 90 Ch to Coplar on Martha Smith's Spring branch m. m. thence down said branch N 15 E 40 8 Ch to St. m. m. thence N 46 E 40 0 Ch to St. m. m. thence N 81 E 2 80 Ch to St. m. m. thence N 68 E 4 50 Ch to St. m. m. thence N 16 E 2 50 Ch to Rock cor. m. m. thence N 85 E 3 90 Ch to (Shoal) rock. m. m. thence N 57 E 1 85 Ch crossing Brushy Creek to North bank thence down said bank to opposite end to beginning corner

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the said Gilham Mills their successors Heirs and assigns forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said Gilham Mills their successors Heirs and assigns against me and my Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same of any part thereof.
