I Stephen Clark in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred (800) Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Ellison A Smyth in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Ellison A Smyth of all that Tract of land situate in the County and State aforesaid beginning on a black lumen 3x on Saluda River thence N 41° E 51.76 to a stone 3x. Thence N 41° E 9.60 to a rock 3x thence N 41° E 4.40 to a rock 3x thence S 30° 25.00 to a rock 3x. Thence S 29° 16.50 to a rock 3x thence N 80° 44' 16.35 to a rock 3x thence N 31° 21.03 to a rock 3x thence N 80° 44' 17.03 to a rock 3x. Thence S 18° 45' 4.35 to a rock on said River. Thence up said river to the beginning containing one hundred (100) acres more or less and adjoining lands of Noah R Wilson widow Colligan widow Estes's Estate and others being the premises conveyed to me Steven Clarke by S. J. Smith Master by deed dated 3 January 1887 and recorded in R.M.C for Greenville County A.C. in Book 88 page 521 together with all and singular the Rights Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Ellison A Smyth his Heirs and assigns forever.
