Vining, Executor of the Estate Jonah M. Vining, for - self - and heirs, executors, and administrators, do covenant, Premise, Grant, and agree to, and with said William J. Whitmire his Heirs and Assigns, by these presents, in manner and form following: that is to say, That I the D. B. Vining, Executor now at the time of sealing and delivery of these presents am lawfully and absolutely seized of and in the said tract of land and Buildings thereon and all and singular other other than the Premises herein before mentioned, and intended to be hereby granted and released, and every part and parcel thereof, with the rents and every of their appurtenances, of a good, sure, perfect, and absolute Estate of inheritance, in freehold, without any manner of condition, trust, proviso, power of reservation, or limitation, or any use or uses, or other restraint, matter, or thing whatsoever, to attorney, charge, deposit or meet the same; And also, that I the said D.
