Roe late of Greenville County and State aforesaid departed this life intestate and unprovided on the 26th day of Jan'y. 1888. Seized and professed of a tract of land containing 386 acres which has ever since remained in possession of his widow Sarah S. Roe, and whereas the said Thomas W. Roe (dead) left surviving him no heirs at law and distributees his widow Sarah S. Roe and seven children viz. Mary Ann Hawkins, Reziah E. Watson, Sarah B. Hunt, Anna W. Carter, Martha L. Ray, Susanna M. Moore and Thos. W. Roe all of which are above the age of three one years, and whereas no division or partition of said real estate has ever been had and being desirous to have the same divided without recourse to the Courts, and whereas the said Real Estate surveyed at their request and expense by A. Dickson the 9th day of March 1888 containing 57 acres more or less, bounded as by plan herewith attached. Together with all and singular their rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid unto the said Sarah S. Roe her heirs and assigns forever. And we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises to unto the said Sarah S. Roe her heirs assigns and our heirs and against every other person person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
