County of Greenville } This presents
may concern: Whereas by an act of the General Assembly of the State
of South Carolina entitled "An Act in Relation to Forfeited Lands, Delinquent Lands, and Collection of Taxes" approved December
24th 1887, it is provided that hereafter immediately upon expiration
of the time allowed by law for the payment of taxes in any
year, the County Treasurer of each County shall and is hereby au-
thorized and directed to issue in the name of the State a warrant of
execution in duplicate against each defaulter tax-payer in
his County signed by him in his official capacity directed to
the Sheriff of his County or his lawful Deputy requiring and
commanding him to levy the same by distress and sale of
the defaulter's tax-payer's estate, real or personal or both as
may be sufficient to satisfy the taxes. State School Fund
and Special of such defaulter specifying therein the aggregate
amount of all of his taxes as well as the amount to collect
Whereas it is further provided by said Act that in
case of any tax-payer who has been served with a

and take exclusive possession of so much of the defaulter's tax-payer's estate, real or personal or both as may be necessary to raise a sum of money named therein & the charges thereon and after due advertisement sell the same before the Court House door of the County on a regular sales day and within the usual for public sales for each make titles thereto to the pur chaser complying with the terms of sale and annex to said title the duplicate warrant with Indorsement thereon of his attorney thence delivered; and Whereas W. S. Thackston the County Treasurer of Greenville County has issued his warrant directed to me by authority of said Act, against Morris Arnold a defaulter tax-payer of said County, strictly charging and commanding me as Sheriff of said County to levy by distress and sale of the personal property and if sufficient personal property cannot be found, then by distress and sale of the land of the said Morris Arnold defaulter, the sum of Five \$5.00 Dollars, together with Seventeen \$17.00 Dollars the charges thereon Wherby virtue of said warrant or execution I, G. D. Gilbreath Sheriff of said County in consideration of the premises & twenty four Dollars to me paid by the said S. G. Mayfield have granted, bargained, sold and released by these presents to grant bargain sell and release unto the said S. G. Mayfield all that lot of land situate in the city of Greenville County aforesaid on Bucket Street (No 50) adjoining lands of Tilda Walker, Connet Mackey, W. A. Hudson and others containing three quarters ($\frac{3}{4}$) of an acre more or less together with all and singular the rights hereditament and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises hereby granted with the appurtenances unto the S. G. Mayfield his heirs and assigns forever according to the form force and effect of the laws and usage of the State of South Carolina in such cases made and provided.
