Julius C. Smith & Co Judson that I William Goldsmith of  
Germville County, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the  
sum of Eight Thousand Dollars to me in hand paid at and  
before the sealing of these presents by Julius C. Smith and Co. H.  
Judson of Germville County, in the State aforesaid. (The receipt  
whereof is in my acknowledgment) have granted, bargained, sold  
and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and  
release unto the said Julius C. Smith and Co. Judson, all the  
free, parcel and tract of land, situate and lying in Germville  
County, State aforesaid, about 12 miles from City of Germville on the  
Scuffleton Road, and being the same as was conveyed to me by W. J.  
Long on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of February 1859, and said to contain 713 acres  
or less. This tract was originally purchased by me in three separate  
tracts to wit: The first deeded to me by P. J. Dairly dated 23<sup>rd</sup> Oct  
1856, but more fully described by survey made by John Anderson  
under date of Feb 5<sup>th</sup> 1857, and recorded by Register M. & C in Book  
Y, Page 9, Feb 7<sup>th</sup> 1857 and having the following mts and bndys.
